

I'm sure I have told you several times about my trip to Uganda fifteen years ago. About how I was ill and how violent it was. But if you haven't heard, let me tell you...

During my time in seminary, the Mill Hill missionaries ran a programme where Diocesan seminarians could go out on the missions during their summer break. It was typical to go to Kenya but by the time I was given the opportunity to go, it was felt that the Kenyan option was a bit boring so in a bid to liven up the experience the placement was moved to Uganda. We were hosted by two Parishes, one in the town of Mbiko, near Jinja, and the other, a small village in the North, near Kotido.




St. Justin, Martyr

St. Justin became a Christian at the age of 30. He was well educated in rhetoric, poetry and history before turning to philosophy. He is regarded as the 2nd century Father of the Church and the first Christian Philosopher.

St. Justin gives us the earliest description of the Rite of Baptism and of a Sunday Mass. He was a great apologist, engaging in debates and writing numerous works about the faith, most famously two apologetical treatises called "Apologies" and "Dialogue with Tryphon."
