St. Maximilian Kolbe

St. Maximilian Kolbe was born in 1894, in the Kingdom of Poland, part of the Russian Empire. He was a Polish Conventual Franciscan friar and a martyr in the German death Camp of Auschwitz during World War II.

St Kolbe founded a monastery which became a major religious publishing centre. He refused to sign a document that would recognize him as a German citizen with his German ancestry and continued to work in his monastery, providing shelter for refugees - including hiding 2,000 Jews from German persecution. Kolbe's monastery acted as a publishing house and issued many anti-Nazi German publications.

He is the patron saint of drug addicts, prisoners, and families.
