**EU Citizens:** A message from Rev Richard McKay from the Migrant Forum of the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales. All EU citizens (those holding EU passports, including their children born in UK and those married to UK citizens) after 'Brexit' must apply for residency in UK. Because there is now a real danger of 'Brexit' without an agreement, to avoid difficulties if travelling abroad with re-entry to UK, it is very advisable to make your application before Oct 31st. It is vitally important that those concerned (including people from Latin America holding Spanish passports and from Angola, East Timor etc holding Portuguese passports) understand the steps they need to take if they wish to remain in UK after 31st December 2020. It is relatively simple in most cases, but you must apply to the 'EU Settlement Scheme' before June 2021 otherwise you could become an 'illegal immigrant'. ## YEAR OF PRAYER

The Diocese's Department for Adult Education and Evangelisation share these reflections.

### **24TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

At the heart of today's Gospel is the theme of mercy. This is the mercy shown to the younger son when, having lost everything he had been given, decides to return to his father repenting and seeking forgiveness. The mercy shown to him is not something he earned but was there waiting for him, freely and joyfully given. There is no sense of reluctance or condition attached just gratitude for the one who was lost but has now returned. There is something for all of us in this message of great peace and joy. God is happy to forgive. He welcomes sinners with an open embrace and a warm heart. When we let go of our pride and present our own vulnerable self to God, there is always an open door. This unearned forgiveness is God's surprise for us. Pope Francis in an Angelus reflection once said; "Mercy towards a human life in a state of need is the true face of love". He went on to explain that it is by loving the other that one becomes a true disciple of Jesus and that the face of the Father is revealed. Can we offer the same forgiveness shown us to another? Can we be the face of God's joyful mercy?

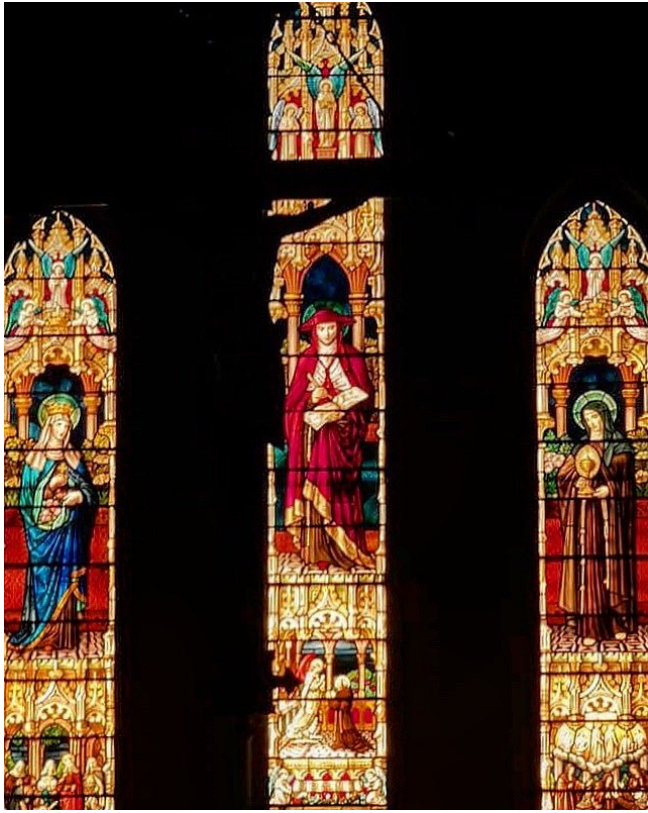

## SAINT OF THE WEEK

**St Andrew Kim Taegon, St Paul Chong Hasang and Companions**



During the persecutions of the 19th Century, 103 members of the Christian community were martyred including the Korean Priest Andrew Kim Taegon and the lay apostle Paul Chong Hasang. Andrew, Paul and the other Korean martyrs were canonised in 1984, representatives of the 10,000 Catholics martyred in Korea before 1882.
